





# **Swiss Buses for Ukrainian Schools**

## Transportation for Ukrainian children

Russia's attacks on public infrastructure have had a devastating impact on the Ukrainian education system. Numerous schools have been destroyed, making it extremely challenging for children to access education. In response to this crisis, we are committed to a project that seeks to provide a tangible and long-term positive contribution to the children of Ukraine by helping them get to functioning schools and continue their education.

## The Project

We, the Swiss NGO St. Gallen Helps Ukraine in cooperation with the Swiss Embassy, are looking for (soon-to-be) decommissioned buses in Switzerland to be used as school buses in Ukraine. St. Gallen Helps Ukraine acts as a communication channel and intermediary between our partners and Swiss stakeholders who have suitable buses at their disposal. Together with the Swiss-funded organization DECIDE, we are handling the legal and logistical aspects of the project. The buses are collected by drivers from the Ukrainian communities and brought to their designated municipalities. The whole project is financed by the Swiss embassy. #### About DECIDE



## Technical and quality characteristics

These are general guidelines for the type of buses that can be best used in Ukraine. If you have a potential option that may not fit the technical characteristics, fell free to contact us anyway so we can check if there is a use case for those buses.

## Capacity

- 20-50 seats

## **Mandatory requirements**

- Diesel fuel
- Anti-lock braking system and auxiliary braking system
- Can not be an articulated bus

### Preferred requirements

- Additional handrails both at the entrance and in the cabin
- Signaling system connecting passengers with the driver
- Compartment for transporting luggage and folded wheelchair seats is provided
- Buses with a capacity of over 22 passengers must have at least two passenger doors
- Mileage under 500 000 km
- All passenger seats must be equipped with lap belts. (can be equipped in Ukraine)
- Speed-limiting device (can be equiped in Ukraine)

## **Equipment for transit**

- Spare wheel
- Emergency stop sign
- Anti-roll bars
- A set of tools, including at least a tire jack, and a wheel wrench
